Abstract Peel Painting Tutorial

What Peel Painting Is

Paint squeezed between two surfaces then peeled apart to reveal all these intricate veiny lines, make a Peel Painting. The ones shown here had paint squeezed between two stretched canvases.

Thicknesses

You can use thin or thick amounts of paint to get intricate or thick texture lines.

Substrate Types

Peel with paper or firm canvas supports for different looks.

Direction

The direction of how you pull apart matters. Each way you peel will create different looks.

Multiplies

Pressing two canvases together with really thick paint will create 2 paintings when pulled apart. Those two paintings can be pressed to make two more paintings to equal four, depending on how much paint you first used. You can keep adding different paint colors in between each press too. There are ways you can make each clone look different and unique.
