**EDUCATION & INFLUENCE**

Practically born with a camera in her hands, Karen focused her college studies upon a degree in Fine Art Photography until 1974, when health impacts from darkroom chemicals made completion impossible.

She never stopped photographing and In 2009, her first pro digital camera in hand, Karen jumped back into the field. She found a tremendous following for her landscape photography and never looked back.

Her mastery of digital editing tools had always been an important part of her fine art photography, but continued experimentation with her digital medium, revealed another level of artistic expression and storytelling.

Her new digital art is fueled by the unapologetic quirkiness of artists like Maggie Taylor, Vladimir Kush, Mel Brooks, and Gahan Wilson and by the strange stories that spring from life itself.

**STYLE**

Each of Karen's digital pieces is "a pastiche," which may contain elements like vintage ephemera, watercolor ingredients, graphic elements and her own photographs, presented with an abstract approach. Each piece is created as a visual thought; humor, strange characters and connections, simple brushstrokes of feeling, weaving their way throughout.

By combining a variety of digital elements in unique and surprising ways, Karen creates visual stories, often containing a hint of magical realism.
