She never stopped photographing however; documenting her experiences throughout her life and professional disciplines of equestrian sports, figure skating, dance, acting and professional voiceovers - even though the lab was off-limits. In 2009, her first pro digital camera in hand, Karen jumped back into the field and found a tremendous following for her landscape photography and never looked back.

Influenced by photographic masters such as Edward Weston, Ansel Adams, Paul Caponigro and Minor White for their composition and use of tones; Karen is equally inspired by the landscape masters of painting for their magical use of light. Both shaped her education and the methods applied to her own photography today.

STYLE

Karen's style is all about The Story, using exquisite natural light to express the Spirit of her subjects. The work is currently 100% digital through post-production, meticulously created in rich tones and depth through multiple layers of construction.
