Moviola film editing machines


"SERIES 20" FOR 16 OR 35 MM

PICTURE FILM • SOUND FILM • COMPOSITE FILM

"Series 20" Moviola Editing Machines have gained world wide acceptance, not only for their quality of workmanship and reliability, but also for their streamlined styling and greater convenience of use.

The basic structure of the machine is smoothly finished cast aluminum. Heavy gauge steel sheet is used for the cabinet and stand. Corners and edges are neatly rounded to prevent film snags. The finish is a durable grey-green hammertone baked enamel.

The modular or building block design of the "Series 20" has proven to be of great benefit to Film Editors. Through proper selection of standard 16 mm and 35 mm components the machine that suits the Editor's exact requirements may be assembled. These requirements may vary from a table model for viewing short lengths of hand held picture film to a console sound model capable of running several individual picture and sound films in synchronism. Additionally, in the event it becomes necessary for the editor to change either picture or sound film size, comparable modular units in 16 mm and 35 mm may be readily interchanged.




Model UD-20-S (35 mm)


