Angie Hanson is a visual artist based in Ashland, Oregon, working primarily in oil and watercolor. Her paintings explore themes of presence, choice, and becoming, often inhabiting liminal spaces where transition and quiet transformation unfold. Through layered color, movement, and form, Hanson creates work that invites viewers to slow down, look closely, and engage with what is emerging beneath the surface.

Hanson's process is intentionally contemplative, allowing paintings to develop over time through pauses, revisions, and attentive listening. Rhythm and flow play an important role in her work, influenced in part by her background as a musician. This sensibility informs both her pacing and mark-making, creating a balance between stillness and motion.

She holds a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Painting and Sculpture from Southern Oregon University and a Master of Science in Education with an emphasis in K-12 Art. Hanson lives and works in Ashland, Oregon, where she is actively engaged in the regional arts community.
